As always, if you have any questions or want to chat, please message me on Class Dojo or grab me at the end of the day!

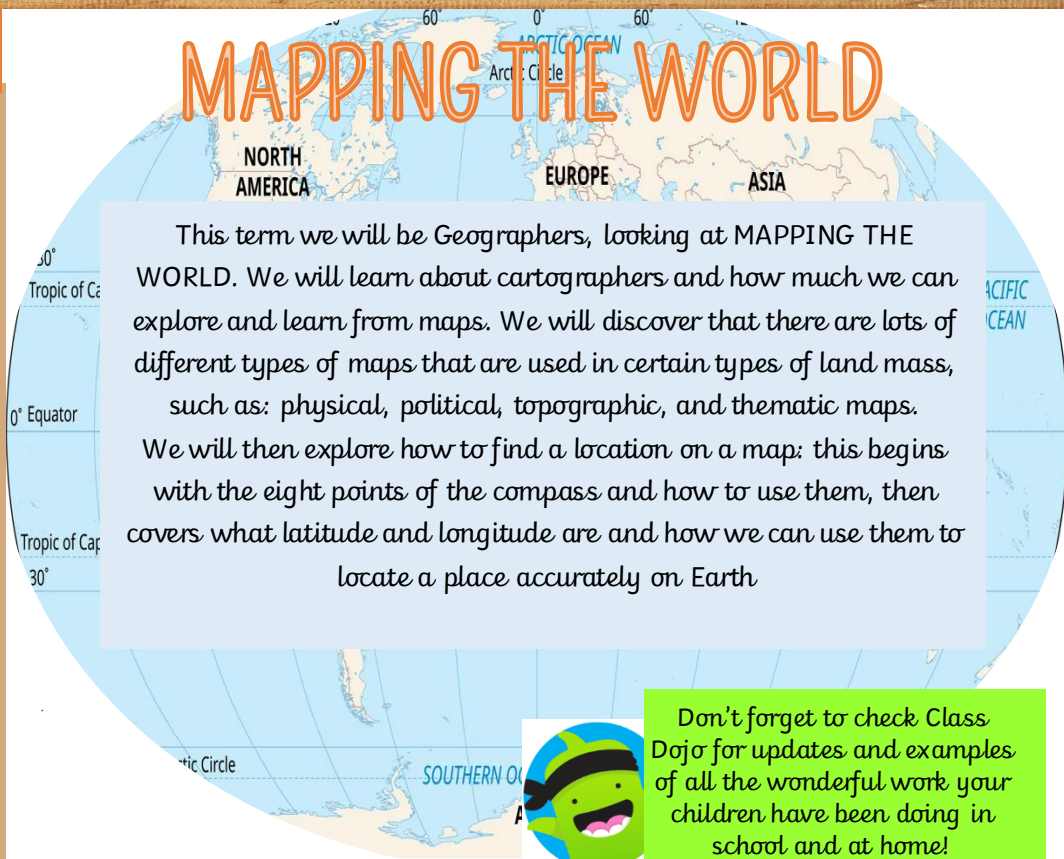

MAPPING THE WORLD



This term we will be Geographers, looking at MAPPING THE WORLD. We will learn about cartographers and how much we can explore and learn from maps. We will discover that there are lots of different types of maps that are used in certain types of land mass, such as: physical, political, topographic, and thematic maps. We will then explore how to find a location on a map: this begins with the eight points of the compass and how to use them, then covers what latitude and longitude are and how we can use them to locate a place accurately on Earth
