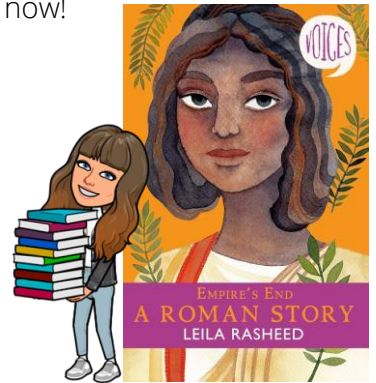
Star of the Week
