Beyond St Mary's

Our Spanish Curriculum aims to give children an awareness of other cultures and have the confidence and resilience to communicate in Spanish for Practical purposes, using both written and oral Spanish. We aim to give pupils a foundation for language that encourages and enables them to apply their knowledge and skills - knowledge, skills and vocabulary that are built on from prior learning and repeated with increasing complexity. .

Year 6

What is the Weather

Pupils will have the knowledge ad skills to describe the weather in Spanish and also present a weather forecast.

Clothes

Pupils will have the knowledge and skills to describe what they are wearing.

At School

Pupils will learn the nouns and determiners for 10 school subjects in Spanish. They will learn how to justify and explain what they dislike and like at school.

Year 5

Do you have a pet?

Pupils will have the knowledge and skills to describe their pets orally and through written means.

My Home

Pupils will have the knowledge and skills to orally and in written form explain where they live and which rooms they have in their house.

Olympics

Pupils will learn 10 Olympic sports and be able to orally and in written form describe athletes.

Year 4

Vegetables

Children will learn 10 common vegetables and their plural. They will learn basic transactional language required for a role play scenario.

Presenting myself

Pupils will have the skills and knowledge to orally and in written form present themselves to others

In my classroom

Pupils will have the skills and knowledge to explain what equipment they have in their pencil cases and school bag. .

Year 3

Animals

Pupils will learn 10 familiar animals and be introduced to the first person singular verb.

Seasons

Pupils will learn the 4 seasons of the year along with a key feature for each season.

Fruits

Pupils will learn 10 fruits and will be introduced to simple opinions 'I like' and 'I do not like'.

Year 2

Transport

Pupils will learn 7 modes of transport including nouns through song and immersive lessons.

In my town

Pupils will learn the vocabulary for 7 key places in a town and a key phrase to match.

Minibeasts

Pupils will follow 10 minibeast characters as they learn their names and follow simple instructions.

Year 1

Under the sea

Pupils will learn 7 sea creatures through song and immersive lessons.

Superhero's

Pupils will learn 6 different superhero's and introduced to a range of colours and high frequency verbs to describe.

Las estaciones

Pupils will learn the four seasons of the year, highlighting a key feature for each season in the foreign language.

EYFS

Greetings

Pupils will learn the vocabulary for basic greetings enabling pupils to participate orally.

Colours and Numbers

Pupils will learn to count to 10 as well as learning 10 popular colours.

Nursery Rhymes

Pupils will learn 6 traditional nursery rhymes through immersive and musical lessons.
